## **Indian Approach to Localisation of SDGs**

- Localisation of SDGs is crucial to any strategy aimed at achieving the goals under the Agenda 2030
- Localising SDGs involves the process of understanding, adapting, planning, implementing and monitoring the SDGs from national to local levels by relevant institutions
- States and Union Territories have created discrete institutional structures for implementation of SDGs in their own specific contexts
- The most compelling vision of the 2030 Agenda, epitomising the well-being of all, is poised on the principle of 'Leaving No One Behind'-Collective Efforts for Inclusive Growth with Everyone's Trust (Sabka Sath, Sabka Vikas, Sabka Vishwas)
