





# EXPERT GROUP MEETING OF THE UN DESA / IASIA GLOBAL TASK FORCE:

# TOWARDS NEW STANDARDS OF EXCELLENCE FOR PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION EDUCATION AND TRAINING

## 14-15 October 2024

## **CONCEPT NOTE**

## About the Event

The United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs (UN DESA), through its Division for Public Institutions and Digital Government (DPIDG) and its Project Office on Governance (UNPOG), and the International Association of Schools and Institutes of Administration (IASIA), is organizing an "Expert Group Meeting (EGM) of the UN DESA/IASIA Global Task Force: Towards New Standards of Excellence for Public Administration Education and Training". The EGM will take place at United Nations Headquarters from 14 to 15 October 2024.

### **Objective**

The objective of the EGM is to discuss and agree on new and updated Standards of Excellence for Public Administration Education and Training based on the contributions of over 1,117 experts from around the globe who met through various global and regional workshops, and an online survey that was administered in five languages.

The Standards of Excellence were finalized in 2008 almost 15 years ago. While the Standards are still relevant today, they do not refer to recent inter-governmental agreements and to the insights from the work undertaken by UN DESA/DPIDG and IASIA in the area of education and training. Most notably, the Standards were issued before the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development was adopted by 193 Member States in 2015. The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development recognizes the importance of ensuring inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all (Goal 4) and the need to build peaceful, just and inclusive societies that provide equal access to justice and that are based on respect for human rights (including the right to development), on effective rule of law and good governance at all levels. Goal 16 of the 2030 Agenda specifically calls for effective, accountable, and inclusive institutions at all levels. Indeed, public institutions play a critical role in the achievement of all the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and targets.

Revising and upgrading the Standards of Excellence represents a real opportunity to profoundly affect the world for good. The Standards are being reviewed to mainstream the Sustainable Development Goals and reflect new developments in public administration. The review was conducted through a global and regional consultative process. It took place between 2023 and 2024. Schools and institutes of public administration, networks, academia, and representatives of international, regional and national organizations contributed their ideas through an online survey and by attending the various meetings scheduled throughout the year.

## Milestones of the UN DESA/IASIA Global Task Force

A first meeting of the UN DESA/IASIA Global Task Force was held in April 2023 where Regional Chairpersons were selected. A first meeting of this group took place in June 2023 to strategize on how to disseminate the initiative among their networks to ensure inclusiveness and to reach the largest number of public administration academics and practitioners, as well as education and training institutions as possible. Consultations were also held in dedicated special events during major regional and global conferences. As of July 2024, 1,117 people had participated in this process with about 900 people in regional workshops. Almost 150 responses were provided to the online surveys.

The table below summarizes the online regional workshops that were held over the course of 2023 and 2024 and the milestones achieved by the UN DESA / IASIA Global Task Force and other public administration schools and networks of Africa, the Americas, Asia and the Pacific, Europe, and the Middle East.

### Structure

The EGM will take place over two days, and it will be an in-person meeting. It will be composed of an opening session, expert dialogues to review in-depth each Standard of Excellence, new proposals, and a closing session. The opening session will welcome participants and introduce the objective of the EGM. Regional Task Force Chairs of the UN DESA / IASIA Global Task Force will present the recommendations from the in person and online regional meetings of the review and update the Standards of Excellence. The organizers will then present the global Standards based on an analysis of the regional recommendations to facilitate expert dialogues to harmonize the regional proposals. The closing session will consist of a summary of the conclusions of each expert dialogue of the EGM and the way forward.

The EGM should result in draft updated and new set of Standards of Excellence for Public Administration Training and Education.
