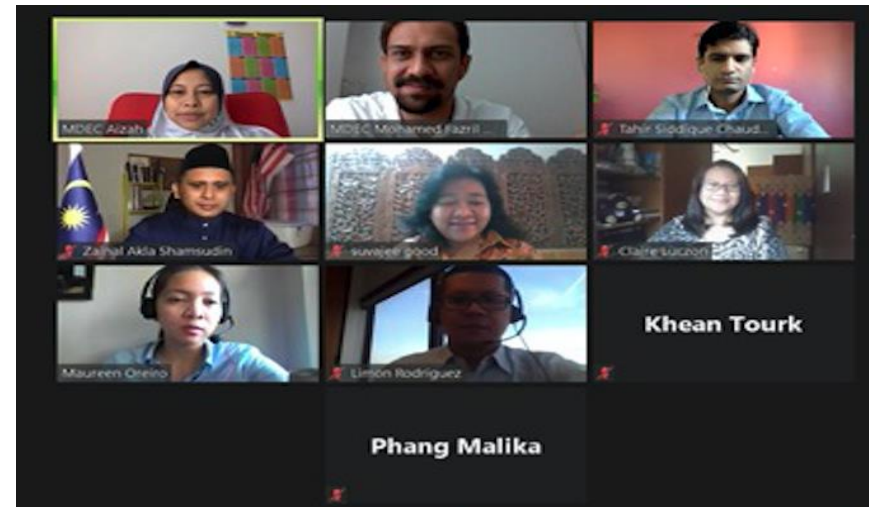

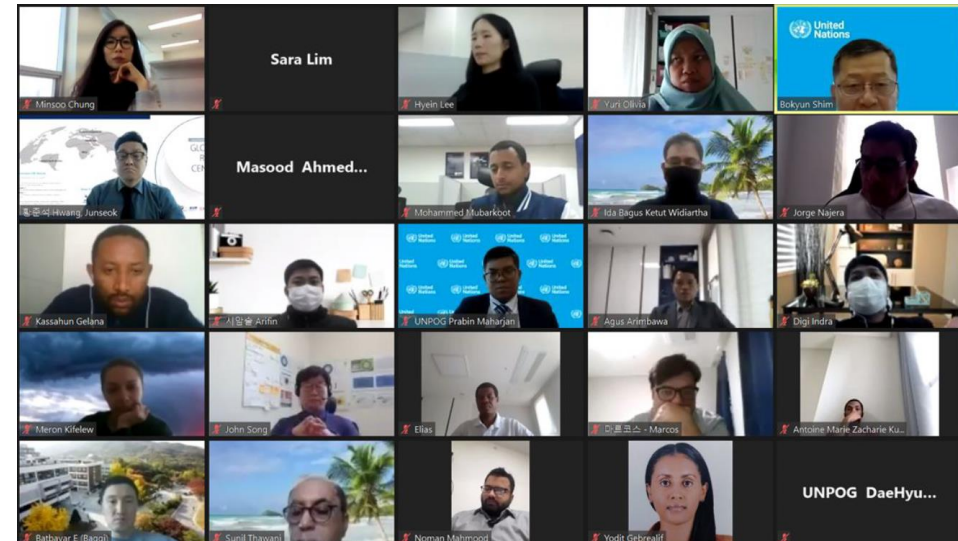
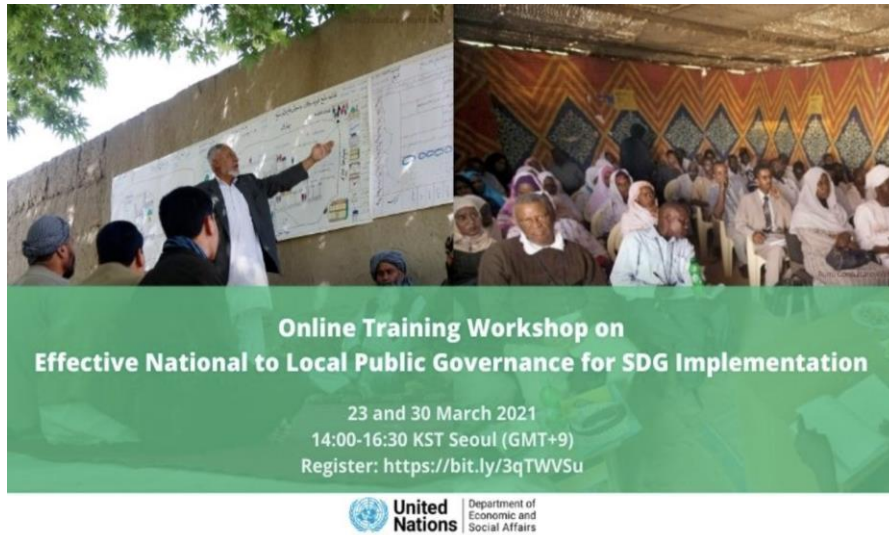
2) Online Training Workshop on Government Innovation for Social Inclusion of Vulnerable Groups (3 & 5 November 2020)



- **82 participants from Asia-Pacific and other regions;** from national & local governments, civil society organizations academia, private sector, IT industry, regional/international organizations
- Covered **selected thematic focuses from the Toolkit:**
 - 1) Innovative Governance Toward Inclusive and Participatory Governance
 - 2) Leveraging Digital Government and Frontier Technologies for Social Inclusion
 - 3) Ensuring Inclusion of Vulnerable Groups during Public Health Emergencies
 - 4) Financing and Partnerships for Social Inclusion
- Included **facilitated group discussions, action planning exercise, etc.**



3) Online Training Workshop on Effective National to Local Public Governance for SDG Implementation (23 & 30 March 2021)

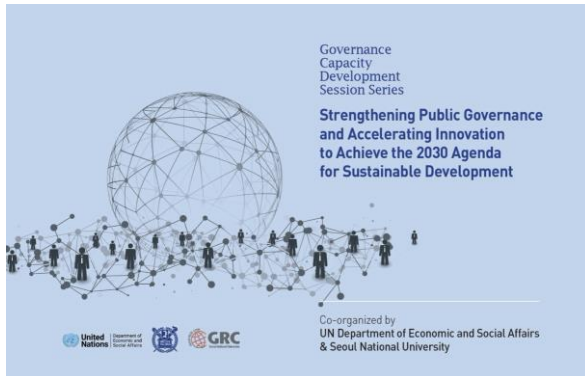
